

Thermal Technology 2019 exceeded expectations with - record-breaking 3,059 visitors

From 17 to 18 October, Thermal Technology 2019 gathered an impressive 3,059 visitors on the fairground of the Knowledge Capital Convention Center in Osaka, Japan. The fourth edition of the fair was also happy to welcome 101 exhibitors, covering the full spectrum of industrial furnaces, equipment, technology and services. 
